

Registration and models control instructions

The road to access to the slope will be open at 7:00 am. The checking of the models and entries will end at 9:00 am in order to start the first run not later than 9:30 am. Drivers are kindly asked to respect this schedule. The organization may refuse to register pilots who arrive at the control point later than 9:00 am.

1 – Registrations checking

The organization will have a control point.

Pilots will be identified by their licenses, which will be given back once the contest is finished.

The judge of the control point will verify that the registration data are correct and that the frequency assigned by the organization to every pilot is the one that is going to be used during the contest. It is absolutely forbidden to change any frequency without the express permission of the organization.

When verifying their registration, each pilot will be given a set of labels to put on all removable parts of their models, as well as a card that will prove that it has successfully gone through the verification of the model.

2 – Models checking

As soon as the registrations are verified, the team of judges will go to the pilots' area to check the models. The pilots have to give them back the non-used labels and the verification form. This form, once signed by the judge and delivered to the organization, proves that the models have already been checked.
